Green Grass 8 – Say, “Yes” to the Dress

1. Tell about your wedding. How big was it? How much preparation went into it? How much money was spent? How much did you do the day before the wedding to get ready? Were you nervous? Why or why not? Did anything unexpected happen?
2. Read Revelation 19:6-10. Who is the groom or lamb in this passage? Why is he being praised? Is this the high view of Jesus that you have when we are worshipping him as a gathered church on Sundays? How can you make this more of a reality?
3. Who is the bride? Where does the bride get her pure wedding garments? Are they granted by the groom or achieved by the bride? How does this give you hope? How are you making yourself “ready” for the marriage of the Lamb? What would you do today if you knew your wedding was tomorrow?
4. Read Revelation 21:9-11. What happens to the bride after the wedding? Describe the dwelling of the Bride. Where does she live? Does it sound like a place you might want to live...forever?
5. Read Revelation 21:8. What happens to those who refuse the invitation? Where do they live after the wedding? Does it sound like a place you want to live...forever?
6. Read Revelation 22:17. How have you heard the Spirit and the Bride say, “Come!” What has been your response?
7. Matthew 22:1-14. Why would someone refuse to accept the invitation to the wedding? Who are those in the church with no wedding garment? Have you been invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb? Have you accepted the invitation?
