5. What are the greatest external threats to our America? What are the greatest internal threats to America?
6. Christians have a dual citizenship as Americans and citizens of the kingdom of God? What is our responsibility toward America because we are citizens of God's kingdom? What is our responsibility toward God's kingdom (and our fellow Christians) because of the rights and privileges we are Americans?
7. Read Jeremiah 18:7-8. What hope does a nation have if God has pronounced judgment on it?
8. Read Isaiah 5:20. Where do you see this verse played out in our nation?
9. Read 12:30. Why is it dangerous to remain neutral when it comes to Jesus?
10. Have you ever declared war on God? When? How?
11. Read 19:1-6. Does you responds with loud applause at the thought that God is undefeated? How can you make this a practice in your life?
