*God is So Good 4*  
*Warrior God: Declaring War on Sin*  
*Nahum 2:2, 13*

1. What is sin? What makes something sin? Is sin just the acts that we commit? What is the power of sin in our lives?
2. Discuss this statement: "No one lives in Nineveh but a little bit of Nineveh still lives in us." Do you agree? What is the spirit of Nineveh? How do you see it in your life?
3. Read Romans 8:5-7. How are you setting your mind on the things of the flesh? What is the result in your life? How does your mind become hostile to God when it is set on the flesh?
4. Nahum lists five general categories of sin that Nineveh was guilty of? To what degree are these sins defeating you?
  - a. Rejection of Truth – "full of lies" (3:1)
  - b. Injustice – "plunder" (3:1).
  - c. Sexual impurity – "countless whorings" (3:4)
  - d. Materialism – "increasing merchants" (3:16)
  - e. False Religion – "gods" (1:14)
5. Why is it easier to see the sin of Nineveh than it is to see our own sin?
6. Read Nahum 2:2. What was the majesty of Israel? Do you have trouble believing that God can restore your majesty after years of being defeated by sin?
7. Read Hebrews 12:4-11. Why does God discipline us? Are you experiencing God's discipline? If you are, what assurance is yours?
8. Read Romans 8:13 and Romans 13:14. Who is your biggest enemy to the Christian? Have you declared war on him? If not, why not?
9. Read Nahum 2:13. Speak the words of this verse out loud as you think about your enemy, sin.
10. Nahum 2:13 give us a battle plan against sin.
  - a. **Burn the chariots!** What is the delivery vehicle to the door of your flesh?
  - b. **Starve the lions!** What is feeding your flesh the impulses of your flesh?
  - c. **Silence the voices of sins messengers!** What is filling your ears with fleshly advice?
