Can you state the mission statement of Harvest Bible Chapel? (Hint: It's not "Make Disciples.")

What are common things that a church does that has nothing to do with making disciples?

Are all disciples Christians? Before you answer read John 6:60-66

Are all Christians disciples? Before you answer read Luke 14:25-33

Are all Christians disciple-making disciples?

What is a disciple?

How does one become a disciple?

Are you a disciple-making disciple? Who can you point to and say, "I made him/her a disciple." Who are you attempting to make a disciple this week?

1. Go in surrender to the authority of Jesus. (16-18)

What did the disciples do before Jesus told them to "go"?

What "doubts" hinder you from "going" to make disciples?

What is the goal of disciple-making? Discuss this statement: *Discipleship exists because worship does not.*

Worship is the goal and fuel of discipleship. Discuss this statement: Where worship is weak, disciple-making is weak. If you are not actively involved in disciple-making you don't have a busyness problem. You have a worship problem.

How does worship fuel your efforts to make disciples?

2. Go in obedience to the command of Jesus. (19)

Name some things that you must LET GO before you can GO make disciples. Are you holding on to anything that is keeping you from going?

Are there particular "nations" or people groups that you have a burden for?

How does it impact you to consider there are over 6,000 people groups and approximately 2 billion people on earth who will live and die without ever hearing the gospel? What are you doing about it?

3. Go as a carrier of the words of Jesus. (20)

Who has or is disicpling you? How are you putting yourself in a position to learn and grow as a disciple from someone who is further down the road than you? How?

Do you daily take in the words of Jesus in preparation to share and show it with others? What is your pattern for reading, studying, and applying the bible?

4. Go in <u>dependence</u> on the <u>presence</u> of Jesus. (20)

Read Acts 1:1-8. Why did Jesus follow his command to GO with a command to WAIT?

How important is it that we go in the power of the Holy Spirit when we go to make disciples?

Are you filled with the Holy Spirit? Is this what's keeping you from going to make disciples?
