**2) A light that shines bright pursues unity and truth. (v. 14-16)**

Talk openly about areas where you struggle with grumbling or disputing.

Paul's desire to ensure the church was holding fast to the word of life is powerful.

What areas in your life do you struggle to hold fast to the word of life?

Do you have family members who forsake God's word?

Pray as a group about the power of God's word in your lives.

**3) A light that shines bright rejoices in sacrifice. (v. 17-18)**

Is it hard to rejoice while serving? If so, why?

Do you see the heart attitude Paul is trying to communicate? Discuss.
