2. Watch out for the hearts of others. (v.13)

- 3. Their sin is worse than mine.
- 4. I don't want them to know the real me.
- 5. I've been burned before.
- 6. I don't need it.

3. Watch out for Christ's persevering work in you. (v.14)

In what ways can you see Christ's persevering work in you? Do we need to persevere to the end to earn our salvation or does our perseverance prove God's saving work in us? Explain.
