1. Where did you get your ideas about what Hell is like? Did you realize that you had formed ideas about Hell that were not based on God's Word when you heard the message? What have you heard or read in the last couple of months about the topic of Hell?
 2. Have you ever been tempted to make God more "likeable" to others by downplaying God's justice? How does diminishing God's justice diminish God's love? How do you actually make God less loving when you diminish his justice?
 3. Read Romans 12:17-21. How does embracing what the Bible teaches about hell affect the way you respond when treated unjustly.
 4. Discuss this statement: "The fire of sin burns now." How have you been scorched by sin? Is there a sin that you need to repent of that may result in eternal fire?
 5. Discuss this statement: "We will never know how infinitely offensive our sin is to an infinitely holy God." How does the sin of God's creatures compromise God's character? How does it invalidate His Word? How does it damage His relationships with those he loves?
 6. Discuss this statement: "There are only two kinds of people. Those who say to God, "Thy will be done." And, those to whom God will say, "Thy will be done." Which are you?
 7. For every one American who believes he's going to Hell, there are 120 who believe they are going to Heaven. How does this contradict what Jesus said in Matthew 7:13-14?
