- 1. What are the signs that America is in a state of spiritual emergency?
- 2. What are the signs that the church is in a state of spiritual emergency?
- 3. What are the signs that you are in a state of spiritual emergency?
- 4. What is repentance? What are the "fruits of repentance"? If repentance is essentially a change of mind that results in a change in behavior, what needs to change in your thinking?
- 5. How does God use prophets like John the Baptist to confront thinking that needs to change in you? Are you using your voice like John used his?
- 6. What is confession? Is it easier to confess someone else's sin than it is to confess your own? What role does confess play in your Christian life? When was the last time you spent more than 5 minutes grieving over your sin as you confessed it to God?
- 7. Revival can be defined as a fresh sense of the coming of Jesus' presence in a life, church, or community. This gives us hope that, no matter how dark the situation may seem, the kingdom is always "at hand." What are you doing to prepare the way of the Lord? What obstacles need to be removed before his path is straight?
