1. Read Colossians 3:1-17
2. What does it practically look like in your life, when you are setting your mind on the things that are above? Do you believe that your real life is no longer here but it is hidden with Christ in God? How does the knowledge of this help you in your everyday life?
3. Do you think about your salvation often? Do you think about the fact that the Holy God of the universe, who is perfect and righteous and just, has chosen to call you, a sinner, His beloved child; Holy, Set apart, and sanctified? What does the recognition of this truth do for you as you pursue Christ?
4. Paul challenges us, that if we are going to claim the call that Jesus has put on our life, we need to put to death some things and put on some things. How are you severely and intentionally rendering useless these sinful tendencies in your life?
