How were you affected by the truth that "you don't have to have it all together to follow Jesus?"

How are you challenged to reach out to others after hearing that "Jesus calls even the outcasts of society?"

What did your life look like before you followed Christ?

As you compare before Christ to what it looks like now, are you encouraged by God's activity in your life?

Is there anything that is keeping you from fully embracing life in Christ?

Repent and follow Jesus.

How have you viewed repentance?

Why is repentance a beautiful action?

What is your story of repentance and faith in Christ?

Does your gospel presentation include a call to repent?

Do you struggle with calling unbelievers to repent? If so, why?

Is there any sin in your life that you need to repent of?

Are you embracing the glorious truth of 1 John 1:9?

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."- 1 John 1:9

Are you more aware of your sin or more aware of Jesus who paid the penalty for that sin?

How are you affected by the statement "repentance is less about what you are running from and more about what you are running to?"

Follow Jesus.

What does following Jesus look like in your life?

Is Jesus calling you to leave something in obedience to him? How can we pray for you in that?

Is the Lord calling you to be part of the Berrien County Church plant? If so, how are you challenged by that possibility?
