

1. Has anyone ever gone out of the way to help you? Have you ever gone out of your way to help someone else?
2. Thinking through history what are some events that you can recall that have broken down cultural barriers?
3. John 4:4 tells us that Jesus "...had to pass through Samaria." Jesus went out of his way to go to a people that were not his own. What lengths did Jesus go to in order to draw you to salvation? What lengths is he going to right now to draw you to salvation (if you are an unbeliever)?
4. How has the Gospel brought relief to brokenness in your life?
5. Have you ever doubted or questioned God's care for you? Read Psalm 56. How does David's reactions to his enemies encourage us in the midst of our doubting or questioning?
6. "The Gospel is attractive to a parched soul." Have you experienced the Gospel's satisfaction when your soul was parched? Read Psalm 63:1.
7. Jeremiah 2:13 says, "For my people have committed two evils: they have forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and hewed out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water." What broken cisterns have you had in your own life?
8. "Redeemed people worship because their souls have been ransomed from the kingdom of darkness and brought into the kingdom of marvelous light." What encouragement can we gain from worshiping the Lord? Does understanding what Jesus does for us on a daily basis cause you to passionately worship him?
9. Over the next 7 days, how will you allow the living water of the Gospel to flow through your life? Share with the group and hold each other accountable this week.
