Describe the world's attitude toward sin. What sins are still considered sin by the world?

The prince of the power of the air. (v.2)

What power does Satan use to entice you to sin?

The passion of the flesh. (v.3)

Discuss this statement by John Piper: "God is not a kill joy. He just opposed what kills joy."

Discuss this statement. "Sin is fulfilling a God-given desire in a God-forbidden way."

What does sin do?

Sin kills. (v.1)

How much capacity does a dead man have to relate, work, perform, or achieve? Why do most people think they can outweigh their sinful deeds with good deeds? Do you think that...really?

Sin invites God's wrath. (v.3)

Does the thought of God's wrath take your breath away?

Where has the wrath of God been directed for those who are in Christ? Does the cross still take your breath away?

• Sin infects everybody. (v.3)

Which of these two paths do you take when you are convicted of sin?

- 1) Excuse, justify, rationalize, defend, hide, blame.
- 2) Confess. Agree with God. Acknowledge my need.
