The Bible only has one epic story – the gospel. (2Timothy 3:15)

Have you read the entire Bible? Do you enjoy reading the Old Testament or not so much?

What is your favorite Old Testament story? Can you explain how that story points to Christ?

Every epic story in the Bible is a chapter in the unfolding story of the gospel. (Luke 24:27)

Because of the time we live in, we have more revelation of God's unfolding plan than those in the Old Testament. In light of this, what would the Old Testament characters like Abraham think of your treatment of the Bible?

Every epic story in the Bible is telling the story of Jesus. (John 5:39)

In what ways does the Old Testament point to Jesus?

Every epic story in the Bible telling my story. (1Corinthians 10:11)

How does the Old Testament tell your story?

Every epic story calls for a response of faith. (John 5:46)

What have you read in the Bible in the last week that called for you to change? Did you?

1) My world has fallen apart.

When did you first realize you and the world around you was broken? Describe your fallen condition.

2) I have settled for less.

List ways that you have settled for less than satisfying things in your worship, prayer life, or spiritual growth.

Where have you gotten stuck?

3) God continually <u>calls</u> me out of my <u>comfort zones</u>.

Is there something that God is calling you out of or into?

Does a desire for safety and familiarity keep you from doing what God has called you to do?

4) I can only receive God's <u>blessing</u> through a promised <u>son</u>.

In what ways has God blessed your life since coming to Christ?

In what ways have you been a blessing to others this week?

5) My life will never be <u>right</u> until I <u>trust</u> God.

Name an area of your life that you are a struggling to trust God in.
