GROUP DISCUSSION TIME

1) ECCLESIASTES 4:1-12 TALKS ABOUT 5 RELATIONSHIP OR COMMUNITY KILLERS: OPPRESSION, ENVY, LAZINESS, DISCONTENTMENT AND OVERWORK.

- How is oppression a killer to relationships? Where have you seen it in our world, and in your life? Are there any who are oppressed that *you* need to bring comfort to right now?
- When we have envy in our lives, what are we lacking? Why do we envy? What's at the heart of envy?
- Laziness kills because of inaction, but what's at the heart of my laziness? What can you do about it?
- Discontentment robs relationships in what specific ways? Where are you discontent right now?
- Overwork steals from others how? How can we back off of overwork? How can our church community help us wean ourselves off of our over-commitments?

- If two are better than one, what are the benefits of companionship? What benefits do we see in this passage?
- How is Christ the true and best companion?
- How can we bring gospel friendships into our home, workplace, neighborhoods?
