- 1. What do you know about the history of the Protestant Reformation?
- 2. How do you define the gospel? What words would you use to explain what the gospel is.
- 3. Before you can reform something, you have to recognize that it is "deformed". How have you seen the gospel "deformed?" (Jude 3&4, Galatians)
- 4. Discuss the definition of sin and because of it, what it does to our relationship with God. (falling short of God's glory, failing to consider God most glorious. (Romans 1:23) It's not something you do, it's something that indwells you.)
- 5. Let's define justification together. How are we justified? What are some ways justification has been misunderstood? What is the difference between justification and sanctification?
- 6. How can God be a just judge and the justifier?
- 7. Do you find it easy or hard to live in the confidence that you have been justified? Why or why not?
- 8. Share about your point of justification. What was that moment like, who were you with? What prompted you and how have you seen change in your life since that moment?
