**GROUP DISCUSSION**

1. What do you know about the history of the Protestant Reformation?
2. How do you define the gospel? What words would you use to explain what the gospel is.
3. Before you can reform something, you have to recognize that it is "deformed". How have you seen the gospel "deformed?" (Jude 3&4, Galatians)
4. Discuss the definition of sin and because of it, what it does to our relationship with God. (falling short of God's glory, failing to consider God most glorious. (Romans 1:23) It's not something you do, it's something that indwells you.)
5. Let's define justification together. How are we justified? What are some ways justification has been misunderstood? What is the difference between justification and sanctification?
6. How can God be a just judge and the justifier?
7. Do you find it easy or hard to live in the confidence that you have been justified? Why or why not?
8. Share about your point of justification. What was that moment like, who were you with? What prompted you and how have you seen change in your life since that moment?
