GROUP DISCUSSION

1. God does everything for his glory alone

- Discuss God's glory, the weightiness of it and how He accomplishes it.
- What right does God have to do all things for His own glory?
- In this past week, what ways have you expected God's glory to be about you?

2. We have failed to do everything for God's glory alone

- Failure to give God glory is a failure to thank Him. Are there things in your life that you are not thanking God for?
- How have you sought to take credit or give credit to another person for something that did not belong to you or them this week?
- If you were created to worship, what is the greatest object of your worship? (*Think about and briefly examine your checkbook and calendar. If someone else was to try and determine what you worship by looking at those items, what would they say?*)

3. Ascribe glory to God alone

- What does it mean to "ascribe glory to God alone" and how does your life reflect that?
- Read 1 Corinthians 10:31; if worship is the overflow of a life that has experienced God's grace. How are you experiencing God grace, and how does that reflect in your daily worship?
- In your adoration - Psalm 96:8 - We are commanded to speak of God, sing to and about God, and give of our time and treasure to God. What ways can you intentionally do that this week?
