**GROUP DISCUSSION**

- 1. Christ alone shows God's love for us while we were still sinners.**
  - Why did God show love to those who would sin against Him?
  - What is the appropriate object of our worship?
  - How is it that God shows, on an ongoing basis, that His love for us continues after the salvation? Give examples?
- 2. Christ alone died as our substitute for sin.**
  - Why is the word "for" the most important word in the Bible?
  - If you were to describe the heart of the Gospel, how would you explain it?
  - How has that Gospel impacted you today, and how will it impact you tomorrow?
- 3. Christ alone finished the work reconcile us to God.**
  - What are the supplemental saviors you have in your life (what do you run to when times are good or hard)?
  - What is the finished work of Christ that Pastor Trent discussed from the pulpit?
  - How does this finished work of Christ ALONE count as righteousness to your account?
- 4. Christ alone lives to secure our salvation.**
  - How does your belief in Christ Alone, for your salvation, impact the way you live (1. In the Home; 2. In relationships with others; 3. At work)
  - Why is it not possible to lose your salvation?
  - How does faith alone for your salvation provide hope for you each day?
- 5. Christ alone produces life-changing joy.**
  - How does this faith in Christ alone cause you to live a joy-filled life?
  - If you're not living a joy-filled life, do you really understand what it means to have faith in Christ alone for your salvation?
  - Do others see a life-changing joy in you as a result of you understanding that is Christ alone that secures your salvation?

- 7. How will you live differently after hearing this message?**
