GROUP DISCUSSION

Read Luke 14:1-24

DO I HAVE KINGDOM HUMILITY?

1. How does Jesus define and demonstrate kingdom humility?
2. Where do you see loftiness and pride in yourself that fights against humility? Do you self-promote when it comes to your own achievements and abilities? What is the driving factor?
3. How are you tempted to bypass pleasing Jesus for the approval of man?
4. What areas in your life do you have the opportunity to show humility and honor others?

HAVE I RESPONDED TO THE KINGDOM INVITATION?

1. How is the Kingdom Invitation necessary and extended to us everyday?
2. Which of the three excuses found in Luke do you use to reject Jesus' invitation? (Possession, Profit, People)
3. Why do we use excuses rather than enter into the invitation of the banquet offered? What do we see is the payoff or benefit?
4. How might God be inviting you towards faith over excuses in the New Year? What steps of faith into His Kingdom do you need to take?
