

STARTER QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever gone on a long journey? Tell us where you went and one highlight from your trip.

TAKE INVENTORY: WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN GIVEN? (19:13-14)

1. Why does the Bible talk about the Kingdom of God so much? What is its significance and what are some ways we can live in light of our citizenship in the Kingdom of God?
2. Pastor Trent encouraged us to respond to the sermon by taking inventory: What are some things that God has given you responsibility for? What are some ways you can use your blessings to invest in His Kingdom?
3. True or false: Every blessing God gives you is meant to be invested in His Kingdom. Explain your answer.

TAKE RESPONSIBILITY. WHAT ARE YOU DOING WITH WHAT YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN? (19:15-27)

1. Read Revelation 20:12-13; Revelation 22:12; Matthew 10:15; Hebrews 10:29. What types of things earn reward? And what types of things earn punishment? What are some specific ways these verses should impact the way we live today?
2. Are there any "little" responsibilities that you have been neglecting? Discuss what they might be and how this parable has helped shape your thinking about them.
3. What are some ways you can multiply what God has given you?
4. What are some common excuses people make to avoid the responsibility to serve the King? What are some excuses you are tempted to make?
5. What are some godly risks you can take for the Kingdom this week?

TAKE A STEP: Take time to bow to King Jesus. Repent of your desire to sit on His Throne. Think of a specific way you can invest in His Kingdom this week. The question is not if or when Jesus will return. The question is will He find your faithful when He does return? And behold, He is coming soon.
