

THIS READING PLAN IS FOR YOU!

Hey Gospel City, this week we are going to go through 1 John together. Last week Pastor Trent graciously proclaimed that nominal Christians are not Christians at all. The genuine Christians who heard this message should come away more in love with Jesus because they are marveling at the fact that they are saved; while the non and nominal Christians should respond with repentant faith in the gospel! What we do not want is for genuine Christians to be struggling with their assurance of salvation; nor do we desire for non-Christians to have a false assurance of salvation. Therefore, let us go through 1 John together. The apostle is not discreet regarding the purpose of his letter. He says, "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God that you may know that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:13). John's purpose for writing will be our purpose for studying: so that you, loved members of Gospel City, may know that you are an adopted child of the living God who has been saved out of this world and born again to eternal life with Jesus. Every single works-based religion coerces people to obey out of fear that they might not be quite good enough when it is all said and done. But the gospel of grace guarantees salvation for all who believe, and the Spirit bears witness with our spirit so that we can know today that we are saved and that we will be saved for all of eternity. So prayerfully read this letter. Spend time praising God because of how He has called you out of darkness and enabled you to walk in His light. Make room for Him to convict you of your need for growth. Then repent and believe the gospel, trust Christ, and go tell others about the salvation that is offered today.

THE FORMAT IS SIMPLE:

We are still going to provide a passage to read and a verse to meditate on for each day. But instead of providing a discussion question and a prayer that is specific to each reading, we will provide a general question and structure for prayer that will apply to each passage throughout the week. We hope that the questions we have provided in the past have helped you and your families grow in your ability to read your Bible. And we hope that the prayers have served as a good model for you regarding how to pray through your Bible. But now it is time for you to take the reigns! Think of your own discussion questions and then pray through what you have meditated on. And we are excited to continue to read and meditate and discuss and pray alongside you as we seek our Lord together.

MEDITATE ON:


By this we know love, that he laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers.
