# **GROUP QUESTIONS**

#### STARTER OUESTION

1. Pastor Micah mentioned "Seeking Him" as a transformational study for him. What is one book or podcast that's helped you transform into Christlikeness? What would you recommend for the others in our group/church?

### **OUR WALK SHOULD REFLECT OUR WEALTH IN CHRIST (4:1)**

- 1. Consider Ephesians 1-3. What is the calling to which we have been called? Think back to the sermons through Ephesians up to this point. Which aspect of our calling has stood out to you?

- 1. Consider the characteristics of humility, gentleness, patience, and love. Share examples from Scripture of how Jesus demonstrated these characteristics.
- 2. Of these 4 characteristics, which one do you need to grow the most and why? How can meditating on the truths of Ephesians 1-3 help someone grow in these characteristics?
