The First Person of the Trinity is God the Father Who Created Me and Cares For Me

DAY ONE

But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me. And you also will bear witness, because you have been with me from the beginning. // John 15:26-27

Q. What does it mean that God is Trinity?

Q. Who is the first person of the Trinity? Explain what you understand about the Trinity.

Pray: Thank you Father for loving us and having compassion on us. Thank you Jesus for coming to save us. Thank you Holy Spirit for not leaving us alone.

DAY TWO

In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of his will, in order that we, who were the first to put our hope in Christ, might be for the praise of his glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory. // Ephesians 1:11-14

Q. God is very different from us. What are some ways God is not like anything He created? What are some ways we *can* be like God?

Pray: Praise God for He is mighty and powerful, and also gracious and loving! Ask Him to help you be more like Him by putting off Sin and putting on Christ!

DAY THREE

So then, about eating food sacrificed to idols: We know that “An idol is nothing at all in the world” and that “There is no God but one.” // 1 Corinthians 8:4

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made. // John 1:1-3

Q. There is only **one** God and He was there before the beginning of time. God created everything out of nothing at all. Think through God’s creation and write down some of the things in creation that are the most marvelous and awesome to you.

Pray: Praise God for His creativity and marvelous work! Ask Him to help you notice His creation more and praise him!

DAY FOUR

For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, “Abba! Father!” The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him. // Romans 8:15-17

Q: Who does God say that we are now once we have said yes to Jesus?

Pray: Thank God for adopting you as His child. Thank Him for all the benefits He has given you as a child of God.

DAY FIVE

I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. // John 17:20-21

God is love because there is perfect love among the three persons of the Trinity. He displays His love to us through Jesus and pours out His love for us through the Spirit. The Spirit unites us to Christ so that we might delight in the Son, and in that union we might be most delighted in by the Father. When we are in Christ, we have joined a family that loves one another and is united together in that love.

Q. How and why does God choose us to be part of His family?

Pray: Praise God for adopting us as sons and daughters! Ask Him to help you “live sent” by sharing the Gospel with others who do not know Him.
